Dear Mr. Silberman:

I want to thank you very much for your patience in allowing me an opportunity to finally resolve the status of my federal campaign donations in the year 2000. I have been traveling a great deal and have only recently been able to obtain the documentation pertaining to two donations that I made in the year 2000.

As you will see by the enclosed copy, on August 29, 2000 I sent check #8973 to the Republican Senatorial Inner Circle. They had assured me that if I noted in the memo section of the check that my donation was for a "non-federal account", that it would not count against my \$25,000 limit for hard-money donations in 2000.

Likewise, on October 10, 2000, I sent check #9051 to the Senate Republican Campaign Committee. They also had assured me that if I noted in the memo section of the check that the donation was a "2000 campaign non-federal donation" it would not be applied to my \$25,000 hard-dollar federal campaign limit for the year 2000.

Based on the records you very kindly sent me documenting each of my donations for the year 2000, it was clear that the Republican committees did not follow my instructions. Instead they reported those two donations as hard-dollar donations. Somehow a mistake was made in their reporting in that they listed my occupation as "anesthesiologist" which is my wife's occupation, not my own occupation.

Once I realized the two errors that were made regarding the above-noted donations, I wrote to the National Republican Senatorial Committee early this month and asked them to rectify the situation by transferring \$10,000 from their federal account to their non-federal account. As indicated in the enclosed letter, the date of the transfer was June 12, 2001. Ms. McBride, the assistant treasurer, indicated that this transfer will appear on their July 20, 2001 report.

I want to thank you for the tremendous amount of time and effort that you put into helping me resolve the matter of my year 2000 donations. Also, I want to thank you for sending me the very




