Dear Messrs. Bauer and Svoboda:

On November 29, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients of the complaint in MUR 5338, which alleged violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). On January 7, 2003, the Commission severed your clients from MUR 5338 and placed them in the above-referenced MUR 5343. On February 3, 2004, the Commission exercised its prosecutorial discretion and dismissed the complaint with respect to PAC for a Democratic House – Non-Federal Account and Moses Mercado, as treasurer, and closed its file in this matter.


