The Reports Analysis Division referred RAD 20L-03 for processing on January 24, 2020, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 957. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Beto for Texas and Gwendolyn L. Pulido, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely refund or redesignate excessive and prohibited contributions for the 2018 General Election totaling \$79,051.35.

The Committee filed four (4) Form 99s (Miscellaneous Electronic Submissions) on November 5, 2018, May 7, 2019, June 3, 2019, and October 15, 2019 listing the corrective action taken to address the excessive and prohibited contributions. To date, the Committee has refunded or reattributed \$78,851.35 of the contributions, while a total of \$200.00 in contributions from two (2) individuals appear to be unresolved.
