Dear Ms. Mitchell:

On March 23, 2011, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Donald J. Trump, Michael Cohen, Stewart Rahr, The Trump Organization, LLC, and ShouldTrumpRun.com, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On March 14, 2013, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe that Donald J. Trump violated 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1) or 11 C.F.R. § 101.1(a); no reason to believe that Donald J. Trump, Michael Cohen, Stewart Rahr, The Trump Organization, LLC, or Should Trump Run Committee, Inc. *f/k/a* ShouldTrumpRun.com violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a or 441b; and no reason to believe that Should Trump Run Committee, Inc. *f/k/a* ShouldTrumpRun.com violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 433 or 434. Also on March 14, 2013, there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that Donald J. Trump violated 11 C.F.R. § 100.72(a) and Michael Cohen, Stewart Rahr, The Trump Organization, LLC, and Should Trump Run Committee, Inc. *f/k/a* ShouldTrumpRun.com violated 11 C.F.R. § 100.131(a). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on June 11, 2013. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.


