On March 24, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Service Tire Truck Centers, Inc. of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by your client, the Commission, on January 11, 2022, voted to dismiss the allegations against your client in this matter as an act of prosecutorial discretion.
